905.01 PROPERTY OWNER TO REPAIR SIDEWALKS.

All property owners or their agents shall repair any sidewalk abutting upon the property owned by him, or in his charge, or relay the same whenever it becomes in bad repair, or whenever it is not in conformity with the rules and regulations and specifications adopted or prescribed by Council. In any event he shall do so within thirty days after receiving notice from Council or the Mayor requiring him to repair or relay such sidewalk.

905.07 GUTTERS AND SIDEWALKS TO BE KEPT CLEAN.

The sidewalks and gutters shall at all times be kept clean and free from all obstructions by the owner, occupant or person having control of the property abutting thereon.

905.08 REMOVAL OF LANTERNS AND WARNING BARRICADES.

The removal of red lanterns, barricades or other means placed on the streets and on construction projects, public or private, in the Town as a warning or protection for the public by persons unauthorized to remove the same, or the willful, careless or negligent destruction of such lanterns or barricades is prohibited.
