1705.01 DEFINITIONS.

As used in this article, the words, "building" or "structure" shall be construed to include any building or structure, regardless of its composition, present or intended use, the horizontal or vertical dimensions of which are greater than ten feet, except auto trailers that are mounted on wheels.

1705.02 PERMIT.

No person shall move any building or structure over or upon any street, alley or sidewalk of the Town without obtaining a permit therefor from the Town Recorder. Such permit shall describe the route to be taken in moving such building or structure or part thereof, and the length of time which may be consumed in the work. Such permit shall, upon the payment of a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), be issued by the Town Recorder if, in his judgment, the building or structure can be moved without endangering the property of the Town or the property of any other person.

1705.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates this article shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and fined not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) or imprisoned not more than thirty days, or both.
